

ALERT – Consumer Product Safety Choking Hazard

As you are undoubtedly aware, the federal government passed a new/revised rule: *16 CFR Part 1500 – Labeling Requirement for Toy and Game Advertisements*. This law requires that specific labeling be added to all advertising media (both print and Internet) for any individual items, or products containing component items, that pose a choking hazard.

As a supplier to Nasco, we require that you review any new product being submitted, and then clearly mark/check the appropriate box below to indicate which “Choking Hazard” label applies to that product. Please check the N/A box if no label is required for the product. For liability reasons, we must have a box checked for each item you supply to us. Return this completed form attached to the applicable completed Nasco New Product Proposal Form. 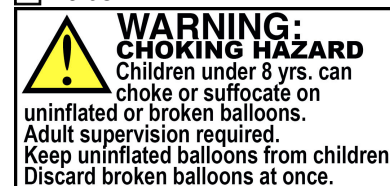
